Discussions will continue in **WORKSHOPS** in interactive and practical level. Workshops are hosted by experienced Finnish early years teachers (M.ed.). The maximum number of participants is 15 and if needed, parallel workshops will be carried out. The participants will be in active interaction with each other and the host.

The workshop program also includes short videos from Finnish Early Childhood Education centres. In addition, participants are encouraged to reflect Finnish system to their own systems through joint discussions. What are the similarities? Or biggest differences? What could be adopted as such? How could we utilize the know-how internationally in a more affective way?
