The Organisation for Outdoor Education in Finland

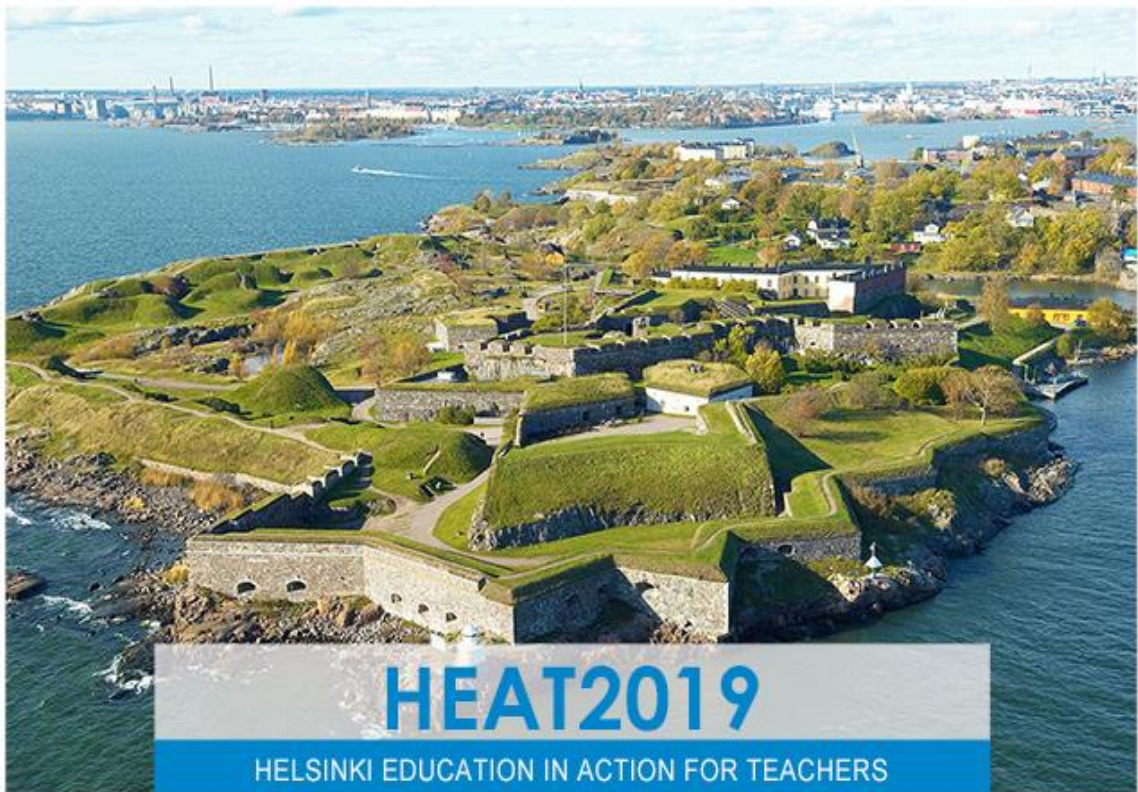
The school lessons will be taught in historical Suomenlinna Sea Fortress.

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TEACHERS' SUMMER SCHOOL

The Summer School curriculum bases on Finnish elementary school national curriculum. The pedagogical approach is in the student-centered interactive and inspiring learning sessions. The concept of “phenomenon-based” teaching, a move away from “subjects” and towards inter-disciplinary topics takes place in the Summer School timetable. The Summer School is like a typical Finnish Camp School which aim is also to strengthen co-operational and communicational skills in the classroom. A strong emphasize will be on transversal competences such as thinking and learning-to-learn, cultural competence, interaction and expression skills, managing daily life and taking care of oneself, interaction and self-expression, multiliteracy and ICT competence, working life competence and entrepreneurship as well as participation, involvement and building a sustainable future. You will be taught by local experienced Finnish teachers. The Summer School opens for you an opportunity to share ideas, knowledge and local practices, which are ethically sustainable and culturally sensitive, and could be transferred from one culture to another. There will be learning outside the classroom, learning by doing and loads of fun learning by sharing. Suomenlinna World Heritage Site has a unique learning surrounding full of history and beautiful archipelago landscape.

EDUCATION IN FINLAND

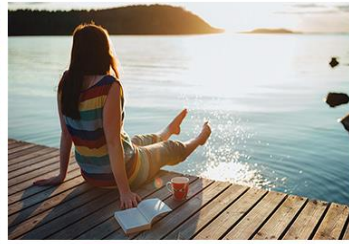
- ✓ One of the basic principles is that everyone must have equal access to high-quality education and training.
- ✓ Each student has the right to educational support.
- ✓ Special needs education is generally provided within mainstream education.
- ✓ The Finnish education system bases on the philosophy of inclusion.
- ✓ Education system is based on trust and responsibility.
- ✓ Educational autonomy is high at all levels.
- ✓ Most education is publicly funded.
- ✓ National core curriculum gives space for local variations.
- ✓ Learning outside the classroom is common.
- ✓ First national examination is at the end of general upper secondary education.
- ✓ Teaching continues to be an attractive profession.
- ✓ Finnish schools have highly educated teaching personnel.
- ✓ Continuing teacher education is widely encouraged.
